Part 1: Speaking - Total 7-10 minutes

Task: Independent Speaking Type A, Type B, Speaking on a visual

Part 2: Integrated Reading - 35-50 minutes

Task: Short Reading, Long Reading, Speaking on the Long Reading

Part 3: Integrated Listening- 25-35 minutes

Task: Short Listening, Long Listening, Speaking on the Long Listening

Part 4: Academic Unit A - 60-70 minutes

Task: Long Reading, Long Listening and Long Writing

Part 5: Academic Unit B - 40-45 minutes

Task: Long Reading, Long Listening and Short Writing

CAEL Scoring

You will receive separate scores for each of the four components—Speaking, Reading, Listening, and Writing—as well as an overall score. These scores are reported on a scale from 10 to 90, and the overall score is an average taking equal weight from each of the component scores.

Scores for entrance requirements will vary among institutions.







What is CELPIP?

The CELPIP Tests are Canada's leading English language proficiency tests. Since all components are completely computer-delivered in just one sitting, it offers a unique testing experience that requires no additional appointments.

The CELPIP Test is available in two versions: the CELPIP-General Test and the

The CELPIP Test is available in **two versions**: the **CELPIP-General Test** and **the CELPIP-General LS Test**.

The **CELPIP-General Test** has four components—Listening, Reading, Writing, and Speaking,—and the **CELPIP-General LS Test** has two components—Listening and Speaking.

CELPIP Band Scores

Each component of the CELPIP-General Test and the CELPIP-General LS Test is given a CELPIP level. Below is a chart of each CELPIP level and its corresponding description.




